

WACKY RACER INFORMATION

THE RACE CAR:

A wacky race car is a boy powered, vehicular contraption built from scrap surplus materials, or any common household items and materials. No ready made vehicles such as bicycles, wagons, wheelchairs, or other wheeled vehicles shall be used as the base for the racer. The car should be constructed from parts not normally associated with a race car such as bathtubs, chairs, or beds. Accessories like sirens, lights, auto fixtures and adornments, flashy paint jobs, slogans and other imaginative decorations are encouraged.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this event is to provide a Webelos Den activity, with an emphasis on boy participation, to design and construct a wacky racer. The event culminates in a novelty race that is fun and exciting for the boys and spectators.

RACE JUDGING:

The race will be 100 linear feet. The top four dens will receive a trophy. There will five other trophies given out into categories: Safest, Wackiest, Originality, Most colorful and Chairman's Choice.

Safety of cars and boys is the responsibility of the unit leader. Wacky Race cars are to be brought with each den and taken home at the end of the event. Wacky Racers must check in prior to the event. Check the schedule for details. All participants must wear closed toed shoes. The driver must wear a helmet and some kind of restraint for safety. The race car must have a minimum of (3) wheels on the ground at all times on (2) different axles. The race car will need (1) driver and a minimum of (3) boys pushing/pulling up to a maximum of (8) boys pushing/pulling. If you do not have enough boys try inviting an neighboring Webelos Den. Remember Safety First.

- Registration will only be online.
- Registration will be capped at 500 Webelos.
- Final registration date is September 11, 2018.
- **NO WALK-INS!!**
- Fees are non-refundable but can be transferred to another participant.
- Cost includes breakfast and lunch on Saturday, as well as a cracker barrel (leaders ONLY) on Friday evening.
- No dinner is served on Friday night.
- This is not a family campout.
- You can campout Friday or come out Saturday only.
