National Youth Leadership Training

National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experience that they can use in their home Troop, Team, or Crew and in other situations demanding quality leadership.

This week-long youth-oriented leadership training experience will be held June 8-13, 2015 at Spencer W. Kimball Scout Reservation. Select National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) graduates, under the supervision of adult advisors, conduct the training using the BSA National Youth Leadership Training Course syllabus.

Overview Of National Youth Leadership Training

National Youth Leadership Training integrates the best of modern leadership theory with Scouting. Through activities, presentations, challenges, and discussions, NYLT participants will be engaged in a unified approach to leadership. Through a wide range of activities, events, games, and adventures, participants will put into action the leadership skills that they are learning.

Objectives of National Youth Leadership Training

- Develop confidence and knowledge to conduct unit programing
- Understand the stages of team and personal development
- Find personal vision and set SMART goals
- Opportunities to share ideas and experiences with others
- · Conflict resolution and ethical decision making skills
- Learn the methods of leading and teaching EDGE (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide and Enable)
- Have fun

Who Attends National Youth Leadership Training

If you are a leader in your unit (Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Team Captain, Crew President), or are looking to serve in one of these positions, then **National Youth Leadership Training** is for you.

National Youth Leadership Training Requirements

- Be at least thirteen (13) years old by the start of the course
- · Hold rank of First Class Scout or higher
- Hold a leadership position in the Troop, Team or Crew
- Obtain Scoutmaster, Varsity Coach or Crew Advisor recommendation on the NYLT Participant Application
- Provide a copy of BSA Annual Health and Medical Record Parts A, B, and C

Where & When?

National Youth Leadership Training will open on June 8, 2015 and conclude on June 13, 2015 at Spencer W. Kimball Scout Reservation, located thirty-five (35) miles southwest of Las Vegas NV. Participants should plan to arrive at 8:00 AM on June 8 and depart at 6:00 PM on June 13, 2015.

What's the Cost?

The cost for attending National Youth Leadership Training is \$200 (early bird) if registered by February 14, 2015. The price includes all food, and training materials. If <u>registered on or after February 15, 2015</u> but before May 24, 2015 the course fee will be \$250. After May 24, 2015, the course fee is \$300 due at time of registration with the Course Director's pre-approval.

Is Any Special Equipment Needed?

An equipment list will be sent to each participant as soon as the Participants reservation is received. Most Scouts participating in an active outdoor program, should have the necessary equipment. Participants must supply their own tents, sleeping bags, cots and personal items. Course participants are required to wear a complete field uniform during National Youth Leadership Training this includes official scout pants or shorts. If you do not have a complete uniform for NYLT, you must **buy or borrow one**.

Fees And Registration:

This course is LIMITED to the first 48 youth paid in full!

NYLT fees and payment schedule are as follows:

- \$75.00 non-refundable deposit due at registration time
- \$200.00 if paid on or by February 14, 2015 (Early Bird)
- \$250.00 if paying on or after February 15, 2015 (COURSE FEE)
- \$300.00 if paying on or after May 24, 2015 (LATE)

NOTE: Deposit does not guarantee participation in the Course. Youth must meet all of the qualifications (no exceptions). Payment must be made in full by the deadline: May 23, 2015. The unit may replace one youth with another under the discretion and approval of the Course Director. If the registered youth cannot attend, and the unit does not have a replacement, the spot is forfeited. The council will create a waiting list in the order that application's where received.
