


What is Wood Badge?

Wood Badge is advanced adult leadership training for all adult leaders and volunteers who serve within the Boy Scouts of America. This training is designed to be fun, informative, and helpful for all adult volunteers, including Cub Scout leaders, Boy Scout leaders, Varsity Coaches, and Venturer Advisors as well as professional staff. Most participants find that lessons and leadership skills learned at Wood Badge are useful for Scouting and also applicable to out professional and personal lives.

Who May Attend?

Enrollment is limited to the first 48 Scouters to sign up! Attendees may be a Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity, or Venturing leader, district or Council volunteer, or professional staff. Space is limited, so make your reservation early. Each Scouter invited to participate in Wood Badge training must have completed the basic training courses for their Scout position and completed the outdoor skills training programs appropriate for their Scouting position.



Two Weekends is a Lot of Time?
