National Youth Leadership Training

National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experience that they can use in their home Troop, or Crew, or Ship and in other situations demanding quality leadership.

This week-long youth-oriented leadership training experience will be held July 20-25, 2020 at Spencer W. Kimball Scout Reservation. Select National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) graduates, under the supervision of adult advisors, conduct the training using the BSA National Youth Leadership Training Course syllabus.

Overview of National Youth Leadership Training

National Youth Leadership Training integrates the best of modern leadership theory with Scouting. Through activities, presentations, challenges, and discussions, NYLT participants will be engaged in a unified approach to leadership. Through a wide range of activities, events, games, and adventures, participants will put into action the leadership skills that they are learning.

Objectives of National Youth Leadership Training

- Develop confidence and knowledge to conduct unit programming
- Understand the stages of team and personal development
- Find personal vision and set SMART goals
- Opportunities to share ideas and experiences with others
- Conflict resolution and ethical decision-making skills
- Learn the methods of leading and teaching EDGE (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide and Enable)
- Have fun

Who Attends National Youth Leadership Training

If you are a leader in your unit (Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Team Captain, Crew President), or are looking to serve in one of these positions, then **National Youth Leadership Training** is for you.

National Youth Leadership Training Requirements (As of March 1, 2019)

- Must be a registered member of a Scouting unit.
- Must have a current BSA Health and Medical Record form parts A, B, and C.
- **Scouts BSA members** (male and female) must be at least 13.
 - They must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops.
 - Must have completed First Class Rank
- **Venturers and Sea Scouts** (male and female) must be at least 14, or 13 and have completed eighth grade, and fall within the maximum age allowance for their program.
 - They must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships.
- Have a unit leader recommendation.

Where & When?

National Youth Leadership Training will open on July 20, 2020 and conclude on July 25, 2020 at Spencer W. Kimball Scout Reservation, located thirty-five (35) miles southwest of Las Vegas NV .

What's the Cost?

The cost for attending National Youth Leadership Training is \$250 (early bird) if registered and Paid in FULL by June 20, 2020. The price includes all food, and training materials. If registered after June 20, 2020, the course fee is \$300 due at time of registration.

Is Any Special Equipment Needed?

An equipment list will be sent to each participant as soon as the Participants reservation is received. Most Scouts participating in an active outdoor program, should have the necessary equipment. Participants must supply their own tents, sleeping bags, cots and personal items. Course participants are required to wear a complete field uniform during National Youth Leadership Training this includes official scout pants or shorts. If you do not have a complete uniform for NYLT, you must **buy or borrow one**.

Fees and Registration:

This course is LIMITED to the first 48 youth paid in full!

NYLT fees and payment schedule are as follows:

\$50.00 non-refundable deposit due at registration time
\$250.00 Early Bird Paid in **FULL** by June 20, 2020
\$300.00 Registration – After June 20, 2020

NOTE: Deposit does not guarantee participation in the Course. Youth must meet all of the qualifications (no exceptions). Payment must be made in full by the deadline: July 13, 2020. The unit may replace one youth with another under the discretion and approval of the Course Director. If the registered youth cannot attend, and the unit does not have a replacement, the spot is forfeited. The council will create a waiting list in the order that application's were received.
